1.	Are you sure you are spiritually prepared for making Aliyah?	
2.	Make an Aliyah to Israel folder. In it you will keep all relevant documents such as passports, licenses, school and medical records.	
3.	Contact you health care providers for copies of all medical records, prescriptions, eyeglass prescriptions, vaccination records. Make sure no to forget dental records.	
4.	Make a personal pouch to carry all items of value; jewelry (if you have them hidden around the house, now is a good time to start collecting them), watches and money. If you have any papers of value, stocks, bonds, even a will, they should be placed here.	
5.	Research schools in the neighborhood you are moving into, preferably one with English speakers. If you have children, try to make the move as smooth as possible.	
6.	Take an honest look at what you have and start to think about what you will ship and what you will leave or sell. Regarding appliances check out our <a href="#">shipping appliances to Israel</a> page.	
7.	Remember to collect any items you may at places like the cleaners or fix it shop. If you have a safety deposit box, now is a good time to close it.	
8.	Use a Shipping Consolidators three column list for documenting items you will leave, ship, or take with you on the plane.	
9.	If you will be doing the packing, get started.	
10.	Place the <a href="#">DO NOT SHIP! Stickers</a> on all items that will not be shipped to Israel.	
11.	Place the <a href="#">fragile stickers</a> on items which need to be handled with care.	
12.	Get a baby sitter for moving day. Keep your children safe and out of the way will you belongings are being loaded.	
13.	Arrange for utilities (electric, gas, water, phone) to be disconnected after you move out.	
14.	Make sure utilities are connected at new residence.	
15.	Defrost and clean out your refrigerator and freezer, and clean you stove, if you will be shipping them to Israel at least 24 hours before your move. It's a good idea to let them air out.	
16.	Clean the residence you'll be leaving.	
17.	Pack your bags and confirm you travel arrangements.	
18.	Make sure you have not planned anything for the day the movers will arrive. You will need to give the move your full attention.	
19.	Make the final inspection of your residence to make sure you haven't forgotten anything.	
20.	Confirm the delivery date and time at your new address in Israel.
